

Fees, terms and conditions

Warehouse storage and handling service fees 2016/17

RECEIVAL

The Receival Fee is payable in relation to all grains received directly from growers into Viterra facilities.

Differences in Receival Fees across sites are as follows:

- Tier 1 and Tier 2 upcountry receival facilities reflect the difference between a receival site's efficiency within the Viterra network.
- Port terminals and Wallaroo reflect the difference between efficiency within the Viterra network.
- Major and minor grades of wheat and differences in commodities reflect the higher costs associated with receiving, segregating, storing and handling minor grades and various commodities.

There are no additional storage costs charged during the first calendar month of storage. The Monthly Storage Fee will apply for every subsequent calendar month (or part month) that the grain remains in storage.

Monthly Storage Fees accrue on a cumulative basis (levied per tonne for grain on hand as at the 1st of each month). Storage fees apply to grain as at the 1st of the month following delivery and including the month(s) up to an including transfer in store or domestic self-outturn.

The Client will be charged warehouse's accumulated Storage Fees for all transfers in store.

ADDITIONAL MONTHLY PORT STORAGE FEES

This Fee is applicable to all grower deliveries direct to Viterra Port Facilities. The Monthly Port Storage Fee is payable in addition to Monthly Storage Fees.

TRANSFER IN-STORE ADMINISTRATION FEE

1. Warehouser to Warehouser: \$0.30/tonne (\$0.33/tonne GST inclusive).
2. Warehouser to Marketer: no fee.

DOMESTIC OUTTURN CHARGE

1. All Viterra storage and handling country sites (where permissible): \$3.15/mt (\$3.47/mt GST inclusive) (Ardrossan and Port Pirie will be deemed country sites for the purposes of this fee) Additional charges apply to pulses if less than 300 mt is outturned per day.
2. All Viterra port terminals (where permissible): \$3.65/mt (\$4.02/mt GST inclusive).

DEFINITIONS

Major wheat grades: ASW1, APW1 and H2

Minor wheat grades: All non-major wheat grades

Pulses: Broad beans, faba beans, field peas, lentils, lupins, chickpeas, vetch

Minor cereals: Oats, triticale, cereal rye, sorghum

Note 1: Unless otherwise stated, all prices published in this schedule are GST exclusive.

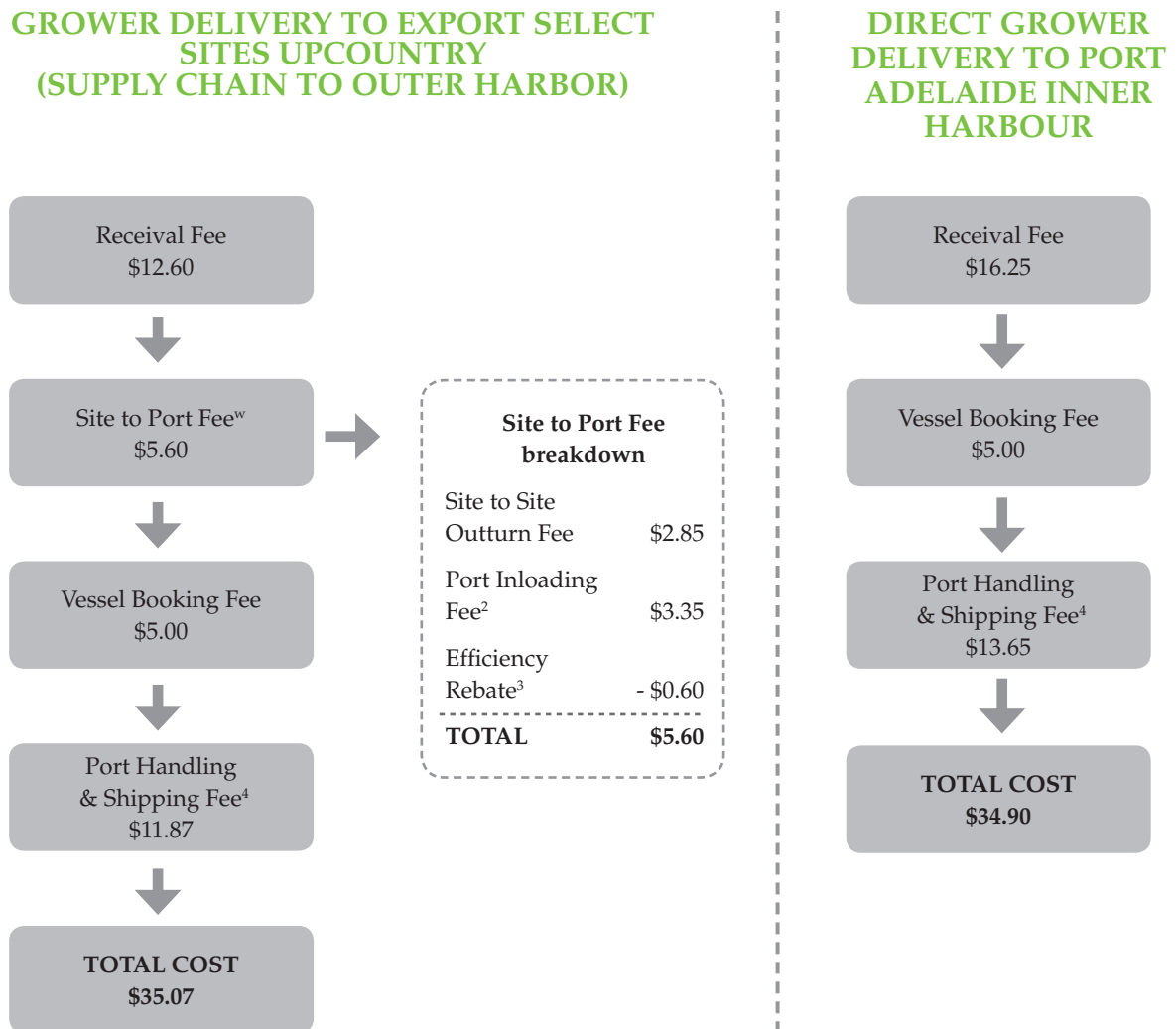

Note 3: Warehouse to warehouse transfers requested more than 14 days after delivery will incur a Transfer In-Store administration fee (\$0.30c/tonne, \$0.33c/tonne incl. GST), charged to the recipient of the grain.

Export supply chain fees 2016/17 explained

The following flow chart illustrates a marketer's supply chain options and fees for exporting a major wheat grade through the Viterra storage and handling network.



1. Export Select freight charge not included and varies by site. Freight is arranged by Viterra.
2. Port Inloading Fee varies by transport mode, \$3.35 assumes rail transport utilised.
3. Efficiency rebate \$0.60 is for client transfers into Export Select prior to 15 Jan 2017 for 16/17 season grain.
4. Rate varies subject to port and shipping periods – \$13.65 represents Port Adelaide Inner Harbour and \$11.87 represents Port Adelaide Outer Harbor (October Rates).

Note: Direct grower port deliveries in storage as of 1 Feb 2017 will incur and additional \$0.50 per month carry fee.
