



FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY NOTICE

Release of Short Term Capacity for the 2020/21 Year

Important changes to dates

On 5 June 2020, Viterra provided notice to all Clients that we will be opening the Shipping Stem for bookings of Short Term Capacity (**STC**) on a first-in-first-served basis on Tuesday, 23 June 2020.

For the reasons set out in this Notice, we will need to defer the opening of the Shipping Stem for STC bookings for the 2020/21 Year. This will now no longer proceed on 23 June 2020.

We will advise all Clients of the revised date that bookings will open as soon as practicable.

Reasons for amending the date

Since issuing our Notice on 5 June 2020, an unforeseen maintenance issue has arisen at Inner Harbour that we are currently seeking to address. The issue involves a failure of one of the shiploaders at Inner Harbour.

We are currently undertaking work to identify the impact of the failure and the timeframe for any required repairs.

However, in order to provide certainty to Clients in relation to the amount of STC that will be available for booking at Inner Harbour and Outer Harbor in particular Slots, we have decided to defer the opening the Shipping Stem for STC bookings for the 2020/21 Year to a date to be advised.

We will advise all Clients of the revised date as soon as practicable.

Impact on existing Bookings

For Clients with existing Capacity at Inner Harbour, we will be in touch to discuss how we plan to execute shipping against that Capacity.

Notice under the Port Loading Protocols

This Notice operates as a variation to the Notice issued by Viterra under the Port Loading Protocols on 5 June 2020.

Capitalised terms in this Notice have the same meaning as set out in the Port Loading Protocols.
