Despite the above declaration, as a part of the quality testing program, Viterra will undertake canola GM and chemical residue testing of the samples **prior** to delivery to ensure that the grain quality meets expectation of customers and the market. Loads will be rejected for delivery if the sample presented is found to have a positive GM result in canola and where a positive chemical residue result is deemed to be at risk to market.
